Which phones can I use? (these are the eButton compatible phones)	iPhone 4s or later running on iOS7 or later	Bluetooth Smart (Bluetooth 4.0) capable device running Android 4.3 or later (over 4,000 Android devices qualify)
Which phones can my Help Contacts have?	any eButton compatible phone (Android/iPhone)	Any phone that can receive SMS messaging (almost all mobile phones including Android/iPhone/Blackberry/Windows)
Do my 'Help Contacts' have to install the eButton app?	YES (including Android 'Help Contacts'). When you add a new 'Help Contact' the 'Help Contact' will receive a 'Request' SMS (existing eButton users will be notified through the eButton app).	NO. 'Help Contacts' simply receive an SMS message requesting help and showing the eButton's location details.
Do I need mobile data (internet connection)?	YES	NO. You do need a mobile phone service to be available so you can send SMS and receive calls. You will also need credit in your phone.
Do my Help Contacts need mobile data?	YES (including Android 'Help Contacts')	NO. Just the ability to receive SMS messages.
How far can I be from my phone and still be able to use my eButton?	The range is up to 15 metres (approximately) if there is nothing to interfere with the phone's or the eButton's Low Energy Bluetooth signal.	The range is up to 15 metres (approximately) if there is nothing to interfere with the phone's or the eButton's Low Energy Bluetooth signal.
Can I test the range?	Put the eButton at a location to test. Move about with your phone and press the 'Check Signal' button on the 'Connections' screen. Do this 2 or 3 times at each location as signal strength fluctuates slightly.	Put the eButton at a location to test. Why are they different?	Apple restricts the use of automated SMS messaging. The iPhone version of the eButton app uses a combination of push notifications and private message boards to notify 'Help Contacts' of a request for assistance.	Android allow automated SMS. This technology is used within the Android version of the eButtonApp. The Android eButtonApp will receive push notifications sent from iPhones and has access to the appropriate iPhone private message boards.
